

Sermon Notes: Spirit Soul Body Session 11 - Pattern of this world (5.21.23)

[Rom 8:1 NIV] Therefore, there is now **no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus**

[Luk 6:37 NIV] "**Do not judge**, and you will not be judged. **Do not condemn**, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

[Mat 7:5 NIV] You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

The Great Exchange:

[Jas 2:10 NIV] For whoever keeps the whole law and yet **stumbles at just one point** is **guilty of breaking all of it**.

[Rom 3:23 NIV] 23 for **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God,

[2Co 5:21 NIV] God made him who had no sin **to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God**.

[Jhn 12:46 NIV] **I (Jesus) have come** into the world **as a light**, so that no one who believes in me **should stay in darkness**.

[Rom 12:2 NIV] **Do not conform to the pattern of this world**, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind (heart)**.

[Pro 22:6-7 NIV] **Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it**.

[Mat 6:24 NIV] "No one can serve **two masters**. Either you will **hate the one** and **love the other**, or you will **be devoted to the one** and **despise the other**. **You cannot serve both God and money** (Gk:*mamōnas*, mammon, treasure, riches).

[Rom 8:6 NIV] The **mind governed** by the **flesh** is **death**, but the **mind governed** by the **Spirit** is **life** and **peace**.

[Mar 4:24 NIV] ..."With **the measure you use, it will be measured to you—and even more**.

[2Co 2:11 NIV] ...in order that Satan might **not outwit us**. For we are **not unaware of his schemes**.

- [Mat 13:22 NIV] The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the **worries of this life** and the **deceitfulness of wealth** choke the word, making it **unfruitful**.
  - [Mat 23:25-28 NIV] 25 "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! **You clean the outside of the cup and dish, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence**. 26 **Blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and dish, and then the outside also will be clean**. 27 "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! **You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean**. 28 In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness.
- [Deu 34:1, 7 NKJV] 1 Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to **Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah**, which is across from Jericho. And the LORD showed him all the land of Gilead as far as Dan, ... 7 **Moses [was] one hundred and twenty years old when he died. His eyes were not dim nor his natural vigor diminished**.
- [Jhn 9:1-3, 5-7 NIV] 1 As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. 2 His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" 3 "**Neither this man nor his parents sinned,**" said Jesus, "**but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him**. ... 5 While I am in the world, **I am the light of the world**." 6 After saying this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. 7 "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means "Sent"). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.

- *Relationship Triangle Handout*
  - [Jhn 1:17 NIV] For the **law** was given **through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.**
  - [1Co 15:56 NIV] The sting of death is sin, and the **power of sin is the law.**
  - [Rom 8:2 NIV] because through **Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit** who gives life has set you free from the **law of sin and death.**
    - Parable of two sons (Luke 15:11-32)
      - *Birth Order*
        - comPROMISE - Balance of grace and truth.

[Mat 19:4-8 NIV] 4 "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' 5 and said, 'For this reason a man will **leave (cleave KJV) his father and mother** and be united to his wife, and the **two will become one flesh**'?"

[Pro 15:1-4 NIV] 1 **A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.** 2 The tongue of the wise adorns knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly. 3 The eyes of the LORD are everywhere, keeping watch on the wicked and the good. 4 **The soothing tongue is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue crushes the spirit.**

[Pro 18:21 NIV] 21 **The tongue has the power of life and death,** and those who love it will eat its fruit.

[Jas 3:1-18 NIV] 1 Not many of you should become teachers, my fellow believers, because you know that we who teach will be judged more strictly. 2 **We all stumble in many ways.** Anyone who is never at fault in what they say is perfect, able to keep their whole body in check. 3 When we put bits into the mouths of horses to make them obey us, we can turn the whole animal. 4 Or take ships as an example. Although they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are steered by a very small rudder wherever the pilot wants to go. 5 Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. **Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark. 6 The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.** 7 All kinds of animals, birds, reptiles and sea creatures are being tamed and have been tamed by mankind, **8 but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison.** 9 **With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse human beings, who have been made in God's likeness.** 10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. **My brothers and sisters, this should not be.** 11 Can both fresh water and salt water flow from the same spring? 12 My brothers and sisters, can a fig tree bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Neither can a salt spring produce fresh water. 13 Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom. **14 But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. 15 Such "wisdom" does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. 16 For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.** 17 But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all **pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. 18 Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.**

[1Jo 3:2-3 NIV] 2 Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. 3 **All who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure.**

[Jhn 17:15-19 NIV] 15 My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. **16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. 17 Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. 18 As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. 19 For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.**
